And, If You're Flying to Goodspeed Airport, K42B....

This request / reminder comes to us from Bill McEnery of New England Airport Associates in care of Goodspeed Airport, K42B:

I'm writing a quick note to ask that we all try to blend a bit better in the community. The airport has been getting a lot of noise complaints from the residents up on the ridge to the east. There are many homes that are right on the downwind for Runway 14. If you line up on the 2nd electrical tower for your downwind, you're going right over some homes with an MSL elevation of about 200'.

I'm not asking anyone to do anything unsafe. If you're comfortable doing so, please try to swing your downwind for landing 14 a bit more to the east, and I think that will help.

Also, please remember to remain over the river as long as practicable to 1000' before turning. Always fly a left pattern!

If you would spread the word, that would be helpful. Any questions, please let me know. I'll make a more concerted effort when I run into visitors on the ramp.
